Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults—|The RCIA is the process by which adults join the Catholic Church. The RCIA takes place within the context of the parish community, and after a suitable period of formation, culminates in the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation-Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.

Formation includes several areas: *Scripture*: The stories of God's people. *Teaching*: What Catholics believe. *Prayer*: How we communicate with God.

Liturgy: How the community worships. *Mission*: How we live out what we believe.

The RCIA is also suitable for adults who were baptized Catholic, but have not yet received the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.
