ASSOCIATE PASTORS' NOTES

Christian Spirituality teaches us that even St. Peter only partially understood Jesus. He understood the identity of Christ **but not Jesus mission**. NEW ENTRANCE PROCEDURE for the parish center offices- A new security system is now in place at the Parish Center/St. Agnes Academy. For any church matters, please enter the east doors at 11th and Cheyenne. When you press the CALL button it rings through to the PC Office. Someone will answer on the intercom, ask for your name and unlock the door for you. If you are coming to the building for any school matters (including SCRIP) we ask that you park in the west parking lot and enter the building through the school double doors (**NOT** the GYM entrance!) on the west side of the building. **For Wednesday morning masses in the parish center chapel you will NO LONGER be able to enter the gym doors, please use either the PC door or the school double doors.** It will take some time for everyone to get used to the new system but our goal is to provide the safest environment for both our students and staff. Thank you for your understanding and patience with this transition.
